

More Cold Weather Tips

Since there is more cold weather ahead of us, here are some more tips to help prevent water pipes from freezing in the winter. The following tips can help you avoid problems when temperatures drop below freezing:


- Know the location of your water shut off valve and test it regularly. Doing so may prevent expensive water damage if a pipe breaks. It is usually located in
 - the basement or crawl space, on a wall facing the street.





- Insulate pipes that may be vulnerable to the cold or have caused problems before.
- Winterize unheated or vacant buildings. Significant property damage can occur before burst pipes are discovered in vacant buildings.
- In sub-zero weather, it may be necessary to trickle (or drip) water in the sink, to keep pipes from freezing.

We can't thank our Fire District residents enough for believing in us to continue moving the Fire Department forward – we truly appreciate the passing of the 6B - Mill-Levy Tax Increase that was on the November ballot. The money will help us doing the following:

- Hire three (3) additional Firefighters/EMT to work with our current crews daily.
- Hire one (1) Deputy Chief of Training and Operations –
- Purchase a new Tactical Tender truck so that we can have extra water available on District and Wildland Fires.
- Increase the Volunteer's monthly stipend that helps compensate for the gas and wear and tear on their vehicles to and from home to the station. The Volunteers work forty-eight (48) hours a month, along with trainings and they are a critical part of the fire department.
- Allow the Fire District to have eight (8) Volunteers working with the on-duty crews and live in the Fire District.
- Increase our reserves for future vehicle purchases to replace outdated vehicles.
- Increase the salaries of our career firefighters to allow them for a better living wage.

The regular Board of Directors General Election will be held on Tuesday, May 6, 2025, and there will be two (2) positions available. More information will be forthcoming in January and February.
